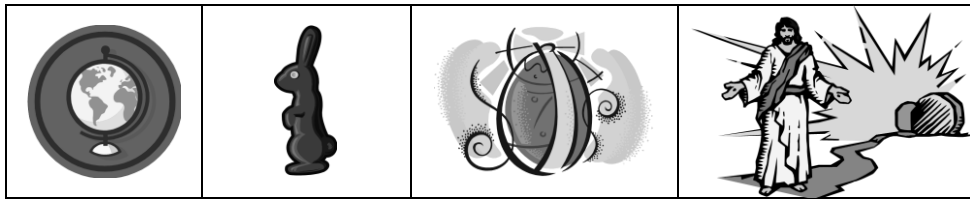

On Easter, Christ..... around the \_\_\_\_\_ celebrate the \_\_\_\_\_ (= the coming to life again) of Jesus Christ, the **founder** of Christ..... . According to Christ..... beliefs, he was the Son of God. Easter is always on a Sunday, but the date **varies** from year to year. Symbols of rebirth, new life, and fertility are common Easter decorations. These include the Easter \_\_\_\_\_ and decorated \_\_\_\_\_. It's also traditional to wear new spring clothes on Easter, and many **communities** have an Easter parade. Easter has also become a very popular time for holidays, since many schools close for **several** days or more.

c) Przeczytaj fakty o wielkanocnych zwyczajach, wykreśl odpowiednie słowa:

- Easter marks the [**beginning / end**] of the [**fourteen / forty**] days of Lent. Lent is a period when we prepare for Easter. It begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Easter Sunday.
- Palm Sunday is the Sunday [**before / after**] Easter. On this day Christians celebrate Jesus' arrival in [**Jerusalem / Bethlehem**], when people spread palm leaves on the ground for his [**donkey / elephant**].
- Holy Thursday commemorates the [**First / Last**] Supper, when Jesus washed the [**feet / clothes**] of his Apostles. In the UK, this day is known as Maundy Thursday. The Queen traditionally distributes Maundy money.
- Good Friday is the Friday before Easter, when Christians remember the crucifixion of Christ. It is a [**public / private**] holiday in the UK.
- Holy Saturday is also known as [**Silent / Loud**] Saturday because churches are very quiet, as there are no masses on this day.
- On Easter Sunday people celebrate the [**resurrection / birth**] of Christ.
- In some countries, Easter lasts [**three / two**] days. The second day is called Easter Monday.
